Success can be defined in various ways, and when we achieve that success in partnership with God, the benefits can be great. At Catholic Charities, we can attest to that, because in 2020 we succeeded in many ways. After years of talking about it, we implemented telehealth as an option for our mental health and substance use disorder counseling programs. We continued to conduct over 400 forensic interviews for children who were sexually abused and offered advocacy and counseling to these victims and their families through our child advocacy centers. We provided services to over 60 children in our foster care program, where many were blessed with their forever home. For Catholic Charities, it was business as usual...almost.

Through our faithfulness to God during a very uncertain year, as well as a focus on what He has called us to do, we were deeply blessed by those who opened their hearts to support our mission. The Board of Directors and staff at Catholic Charities experienced a year where grants from foundations were awarded to us, and contributions from many new donors were not only recognized, but celebrated. 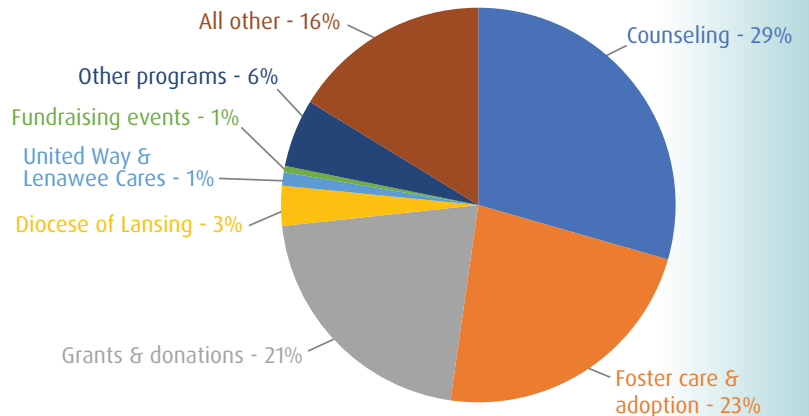

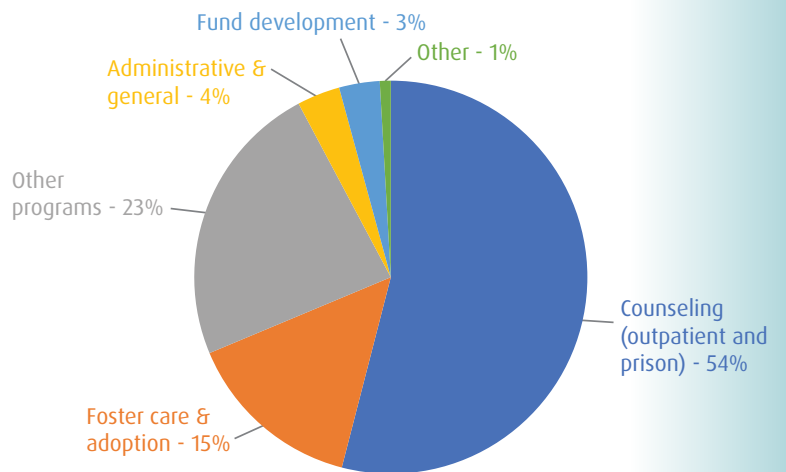

Senior Transportation: Although this critical program was completely shut down for 4 months in 2020, we still provided 590 trips to medical appointments for seniors who would not otherwise have transportation.



Foster Care: In 2020, we had 75-100% more children in foster care, increasing our placement from a yearly range of 30-40 to 60-70 children in care at any given time.



Counseling: Despite the challenges of physical shutdowns, in 2020 we continued to assist our clients remotely with the blessing of grant funding, which allowed us to establish remote telehealth sessions.

Child Advocacy Centers: Our two CACs were able to adapt to shutdowns and implement technological solutions to continue to serve children safely, which included telehealth therapy. They also introduced the use of tele-forensic interviews. Collectively, our centers conducted 448 interviews.



Adoption: Undeterred by considerable obstacles due to the pandemic, we were able to place five children in their forever homes.

SUD Services – Prison-based: Even with prisons being shut down to SUD services, we had a 93% successful completion rate for Phase II and a 94% successful completion rate for advanced substance abuse treatment. We were blessed to be able to add 3 prisons, which will provide services to approximately 660 individuals per year.
