Executive Director's Message

Dear Friends of Catholic Charities,

I wish that I could report all positives in post-pandemic year 2021, but unfortunately, we at Catholic Charities experienced significant aftereffects of 2020 in all our programs. With the nature of our business and the services we provide, this was seen more prominently in our agency than perhaps other non-profits. The most devastating was the impact we saw on children, evidenced by the overwhelming number of children being served across our programs from our Child Advocacy Centers, to foster care, and counseling. The number of children in our foster care program was the highest in the history of our agency. All of this presents a huge challenge to those of us trying to do as Jesus commanded us to do.

Even though we maintained financial stability throughout 2021, we were unable to meet the demand for services. Like many other human service agencies, the availability of professionals to provide services was and continues to be our greatest challenge.

There is hope, however, for a positive year ahead. In keeping with our mission, we will strive to continue to *provide help* and *create hope* to the most vulnerable...our children. We will always be committed to helping those without a voice, and in 2021 demonstrated that commitment by enhancing children's services through the development of our new Children's Trauma Assessment Center.

Looking back over the past year, my heart is filled with gratitude, to our faithful donors, volunteers, and employees. I continue to appreciate the guidance and dedication of our Board of Directors in keeping us focused on our mission in all we do. What we need more than ever before in the year ahead are your prayers. As St. Teresa of Calcutta said, "I used to believe that prayer changes things, but now I know that prayer changes us, and we change things."

Thank you all for being partners with Catholic Charities in our mission of bringing hope to the most vulnerable in our communities.

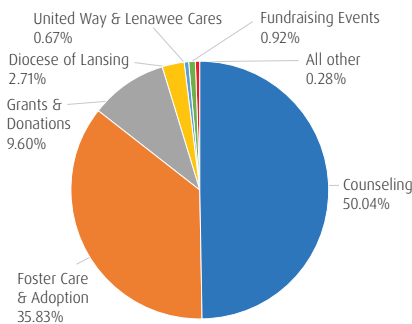

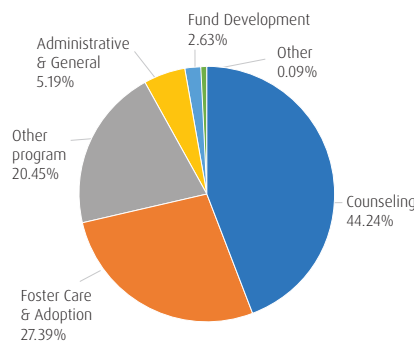

A new project started in 2021 thanks to a collaboration with Holy Family Parish in Adrian, our dedicated staff and hardworking volunteers.

Our Children's Trauma Assessment Center (CTAC) helps evaluate children and provides referrals for outside services to help them heal.



SUMMER STAFF GATHERING

Our dedicated staff and several Board members enjoyed a summer gathering. This was a welcome opportunity to greet new staff and reunite with some of our remote staff.

Transportation provided **690** trips for seniors to medical appointments.

Mental Health and Substance Use Disorder services provided **8,519** counseling sessions.

Catholic Charities averaged **61** children in foster care at any given time.

552 Total forensic interviews for both CAC's

Did you know?

CCJLHC has staff in eleven prisons across the State of Michigan. We provided services to 927 offenders with a 91% success rate.

CHILD ADVOCACY CENTERS (CAC)

Our Jackson County Child Advocacy Center (CAC) coordinated and completed forensic interviews with 314 children in 2021. These children received advocacy support and many were helped through therapy services. Our Lenawee County CAC provided services to 234 children. At both CACs, children are offered a Comfort Quilt made and donated by talented volunteers, reminding the children their community cares about them.



FOSTER CARE

Our Foster Care program served 93 children in 2021. Working with our staff, eight of these children were successfully reunited with their families. Our Adoption program finalized 17 adoptions, providing children with 'forever' families. Our Child Welfare staff also operates the Roadmap to Graduation program, which had one student complete graduation in 2021.
