## **COVID-19 Update**

For everyone, life has changed during this pandemic. Our agency is no exception. Each and every aspect of our agency has seen changes to our work processes, staffing, caseload, and funding. Across our agency, we have implemented new policies to keep our staff, clients, and volunteers as safe as possible when in our buildings, including mask requirements, staggered scheduling, social distancing, and more.

Our use of new technologies has allowed us to offer remote **Counseling** options for our clients. Each therapist and other professional staff has been provided the appropriate computer software and equipment which enables them to meet with clients remotely during the shutdown. The funding for new equipment, technology, and licensing for using it all came at a significant cost to the agency. We are pleased to report that grants were received to help offset these costs from a variety of community foundations. Although in-person sessions have resumed for most, this offers a new way for medically fragile clients to continue receiving the support they need.

Foster Care staff have worked through the pandemic to ensure every child has a

safe place to sleep at night and that foster families are provided the support they need. The staff at our **Child Advocacy Centers** have continued their important work despite challenges of meeting remotely.

In March, we temporarily paused our **Senior Transportation** program and our **Personal Needs and Linen Closet** facility. These two programs serve populations at high-risk for Covid-19. Both programs are working to fully reopen, with necessary safety precautions in place for both volunteers and clients.

Most of our prison-based **Substance Use Disorder** staff are back in the prisons across the State, providing counseling support for those struggling with drug and alcohol addiction.

**Christmas in July - Operation Good Cheer** 



We are teaming up with Children & Family Services' *Operation Good Cheer* again this year to provide our foster children with Christmas gifts.

Operation Good Cheer is an all volunteer program that purchases Christmas gifts for children in **Foster Care** across the State, then coordinates their delivery by airplane to partner foster care programs. Each program then ensures the gifts make it to the children in their care.

The cost to enroll each child in the program is \$30, but because of the generous donations from across Michigan, foster children end up receiving gifts worth far more than the enrollment fee reflects. We are still in need of donations to help cover their enrollment cost for the children we serve at Catholic Charities.
