JCCAC Expansion and Renovation Project

We are excited to announce that we are close to breaking ground for the Jackson County Child Advocacy Center (JCCAC) expansion and renovation project. We still have a few more items to confirm before we commence this muchneeded undertaking for the children who face sexual and severe physical abuse in our community. All services provided at our CACs are free to the child and their nonoffending caregiver. The demand for these services in our community is high, and as we recover from the pandemic, we expect the number of cases to increase. This expanded and more-efficient space will help us better serve our clients.

Catholic Charities has provided foster care services for twentyseven years. The foster care program works with children up to seventeen years old who have been removed from their parental home due to severe abuse, neglect, and/or abandonment. Children are placed with licensed foster homes or relative homes during this time. The homes are monitored by the foster care licensing department and foster care department to ensure the children are in a safe, nurturing, and loving environment. Children are provided with multiple services while in our care, including individual therapy, family therapy, horse therapy, inhome therapy, quarterly trauma assessments, trauma therapy, psychological and psychiatric services, educational services (IEP, tutoring etc.) and medical/physical health services. Catholic Charities offers complimentary interventions to our foster children, which is quite unique to our foster care program. We feel it is important for children to be connected to their community. To help with this connection, we secure grants to assist our foster parents with engaging the children in extracurricular activities in their community. Children can participate in activities such as dance lessons, soccer, musical instrument lessons, or art classes.

The foster care program also works directly with the children's birth family to assist with rectifying the issues that brought the children into foster care. Families are involved with developing a treatment plan specific to their needs, which will assist them with addressing the issues. Catholic Charities is strongly committed to family reunification in a timely manner, providing that the involved child's health, safety, and wellbeing can be protected in the home setting. If reunification is not possible, we work to secure an alternate permanent placement for the child, one that is best suited to the child's needs. Our foster care program always strives to act in the best interests of the child and family.
