General Statement of Duties

- Be an integral part of the Council of Accreditation (COA) re-accreditation and strategic planning processes for the agency.
- Commit to the philosophy of continuous improvement and be a primary member of the Performance and Quality Improvement Team (PQI) providing quarterly measurement results.
