
Hello Catholic Charities,

We say it in every newsletter - we need you to consider becoming a foster parent. Want to know why? Tracey Ventola, Child Welfare Director tells us this:

Every child should grow up with the love and protection of a family. There are approximately 10,000 children placed in foster care in Michigan with a critical shortage of foster homes to provide a safe and caring home. There has been a steady decline in foster homes over the past several years and children coming into care are having to be split from siblings at placement, placed outside their community or in residential or group home settings when there are no foster homes available. As the director of the foster care and adoption program at Catholic Charities, I ask:

"Do you or anyone you know have it in your heart to help children in need?"
